Step 1: Apply to FRCC

Applying to FRCC is easy:

- Applying to FRCC is **FREE**
- There are no application deadlines

Application Instructions

- To start your application by clicking the *Create an Account* tab to enter basic information and create your application username (your personal email address) and password. You can save your work and log into your application account at any time to finish your application.
- On the **Academic Information** application section, under **Student Type**, you will answer the first question: *Are you a student at another college and/or plan to attend our college for one semester only?* as “**YES**”. o Under **Academic Plans**, select your **Area of Interest** as *All*
- After you apply, you'll receive a welcome email within 3-5 business days with all the information you need to get started. **Be sure to check you SPAM or JUNK email if you don't see this email within 3-5 business days.**

Apply Now

Once registered, you will receive a student number (S number) and access to ewolf, the student portal. Ewolf is where students can register for classes.

Search for ‘FSW’ or ‘OUT’ and the class options you are looking for will appear.

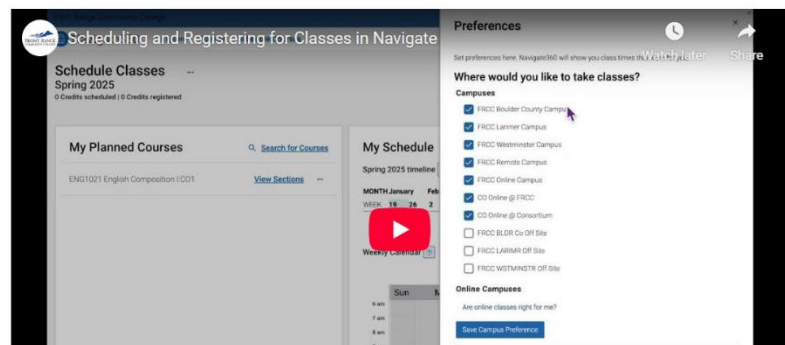
